Key Points from our Membership Rules - 2019

Withdrawal from membership

5. Any ordinary member may withdraw from the association by giving notice in writing signed by a duly authorised officer at least six months before the end of any financial year. You will need to pay any unpaid subscription for the current year and also for any further year(s) you agreed to pay for when you were elected. You will stop being a member at the end of the financial year. If you fail to give notice, you will have to pay the subscription for the following year and, in cases where you agreed to pay for longer, you will be legally responsible for these subscriptions as well.
6. The position on withdrawal for any member not an ordinary member is the same as for ordinary members.
7. You cannot transfer any membership rights. Nothing in these rules will affect our rights to claim the full amount of the subscriptions which you guaranteed to pay or prevent you from again becoming eligible for membership.

Rights of membership

8. Ordinary members are entitled to share in all the benefits we provide. However, any commercial exploitation of the benefits must be approved by the board in writing and may be subject to any restriction the board considers appropriate.
9. If there is any dispute about these rules, the decision of the directors will be final.

Admitting members

10. We will not admit you as a member unless you have signed an Application for Membership setting out any details the directors ask for and paid the subscription
11. The directors (of BSRIA) will decide who can become a member of the association.

Discipline and removing members

12. The directors can remove any member for any of the following reasons:-
 - a. If you have gone into liquidation, or in the case of a partnership, are dissolved (other than if a partner has died or retired) or enter into any arrangement for the benefit of your creditors generally.
 - b. If an administrative receiver, administrator or similar officer is appointed over your business (or any significant part of it) and this continues after 14 days.
 - c. If you have failed to make any payment in connection with your membership within three months of it being due or have failed to comply with the articles or these rules.
 - d. If you are no longer eligible to be a member of the association.
 - e. If you have acted in a way which may damage the building services industry or bring us into disrepute.
13. If we remove you as a member, we will not refund any subscriptions.
14. If we do remove you, you are still legally responsible for paying your subscriptions which may still be due.
